BOWLING RULES HANDOUT

ELIGIBILITY RULES

1. You must have a University of Tennessee ID to participate. NO ID, NO PLAY...NO EXCEPTIONS!
2. No Person shall play on more than one single sex and co-rec team per sport. If caught doing so by supervisor or official, Player shall be suspended for remainder of season and that game shall be forfeited. Opposing team does not have to protest if caught by supervisor or official.
3. No person shall use false identification in order to participate. If caught, person will be suspended from Intramural Sports and possibly RecSports for a period of time determined by the Intramural Program Coordinator.

THE GAME:

1. Game time is forfeit time. Any team that forfeits will not be eligible for playoffs. If a team wishes to drop from league competition without being charged for a forfeit, the team captain must **call by the Intramural Office by 3 p.m.** on the day of the contest.
2. Bowling leagues will be conducted at the U.C. DownUnder lanes, which are located in the basement of the University Center. The charge will be \$10.00 per-team, per match, which includes the shoe rental.
3. Four (4) players will constitute a team, one (1) of whom is the team captain.
4. Substitution: Once you begin a game, you need to bowl a complete game, but another player can substitute in at the start of a new game. If a participant is unable to complete a game their total pinfall to that point will be their score.
5. Each participant will bowl two (2) games per match.

6. The winner will be determined by the total pinfall during the 4 week bowling season. If there is a tie there will be a 3 game set scheduled as close to the end of the 4 week season as possible to determine the winner
7. This is an official Intramural Event. All rules pertaining to alcohol, smoking, and smokeless tobacco will be enforced. Participants that violate the rules stated in the Intramural Participant Handbook will not be allowed to participate, and disciplinary action may result for inappropriate behavior.
8. All other issues and problems that occur are at the ruling of the Intramural Manager on duty.
