- Develop professional relationships with co-workers, participants and guests
- Uphold and exceed the expectations of the RecSports mission, vision, and values
- Demonstrate a desire to learn and apply knowledge as a RecSports ambassador
- Take ownership of RecSports facilities and programs by exhibiting a responsible work ethic
- Promote and maintain cleanliness and appearance within and the areas surrounding RecSports facilities
- Enforce RecSports policies and procedures to promote participant safety and satisfaction
- Respond to all emergency situations and adhere to established protocol including pre- and post- incident procedures

Job Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Recognize and respond to emergencies
- Administer CPR/AED and First Aid in an emergency
- Prevent injuries by eliminating hazardous situations and behaviors
- Enforce rules, regulations, and policies
- Greet patrons entering the facility and ensure all participants present a valid VolCard
- Conduct facility safety checks
- Participate in departmental Fall Semester training and all in-service trainings
- Maintain current American Red Cross Lifeguard/CPR/AED/First Aid certification
- Perform all other duties as assigned by the Associate Director or Graduate Assistant

Qualifications:

- Current American Red Cross Lifeguard/CPR/AED/First Aid certification
- Successfully complete the pre-employment skill evaluation
- Contribute a minimum of 9 hrs/ week; additional special event hours required

Pay Rate: Base pay - \$7.75/ hour; Summer Pay - \$8.75/ hour; Event Pay - \$10.75/ hour
